1. Purpose

To establish the Coomalie Community Government Council's guidelines for Council's annual event to recognise efforts of Volunteers in the Community.

2. Principles

Council endeavours to recognise the contribution of all volunteers within the Shire, as such it will hold an annual recognition event.

3. Policy Statement

3.1 Policy

Coomalie Community Government Council will host an event to recognise the efforts of volunteers in the Coomalie Community.

The event will be held annually in January to coincide with the annual Australia Day Community Event and Citizen of the Year celebrations. This is to be an alcohol-free event.

Volunteers

A Register will be maintained annually by Council Staff.

Prior to the event, Council will call for any additions to this register.

Volunteers on the register will then be invited to the event and all recognised equally with a certificate. There are to be no winners, but instead a recognition of all who have contributed to the community in a volunteer capacity throughout the year.

Certificates

Certificates with the Coomalie Community Government Council logo are to be presented to all volunteers on the day.
