IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- When upon a public place the animal is to be under the control of a competent person, and it is preferred that at such be retained by a leash, cord, chain or similar device.
- It is advisable that the animal wears its current identification tag issued by the Coomalie Community Government Council as for example this will assist in its return if it is lost.
- If the owner of the dog has not reached the age of 18 then a parent or guardian must sign this form as a joint owner.
- A person who is registering the animal on behalf of its owner is required to show that authority in writing. This is to be attached to the application.

DECLARATION

I declare that the particulars of my application to be true. I understand that it is an offence for a dog to: Be at large, to attack or threaten a person or another animal or to cause a nuisance by continually barking. Please note that it is an offence to make a false statement or declaration.
