To achieve compliance with Australian equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards (AIFRS) as they apply to not-for-profit entities, other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board, Urgent Issues Group Interpretations (UIGs) and relevant Northern Territory legislation.

POLICY SUMMARY

The Policy explains the accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the annual financial statements. These statements are prepared in accordance with Australian equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards (AIFRS) as they apply to not-for-profit entities, other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board, Urgent Issues Group Interpretations (UIGs) and relevant Northern Territory legislation.

BACKGROUND

To achieve an unqualified audit report on the Annual Financial Statements. Coomalie Shire is incorporated under the Northern Territory *Local Government Act* and has its principal place of business at 141 Cameron Road Batchelor, Northern Territory, Australia. Annual financial statements are prepared pursuant to the requirements of the *Local Government Act* and the relevant accounting standards.
